

Dear Requestor,

On 03/13/2026, you made a request for records under the Freedom of Information Act, and the City continues to work on processing your request for records. Please click on the link below to view the request details.

As set forth in Section 140/3(e) of the Freedom of Information Act, a public body may extend the time to respond to a FOIA request by up to five (5) business days for a limited number of reasons, per 5 ILCS 140/3(e). Therefore, the Champaign Police Department is extending the time to respond to your request by the allowed five (5) business days for the following reason(s).

_____ The requested records are stored in whole or in part at other location(s).

_____ The request requires the collection of a substantial number of specified records.

_____ The request is couched in categorical terms and requires an extensive search for the records responsive to it.

_____ The requested records have not been located in the course of routine search and additional efforts are being made to locate them.

_____ The requested records require examination and evaluation by personnel having the necessary competence and discretion to determine if they are exempt from disclosure under Section 7 of this Act or should be revealed only with appropriate deletions.

X_____ The request for records cannot be complied with by the public body within the time limits prescribed without unduly burdening or interfering with our operations.

_____ There is a need for consultation, which shall be conducted with all practicable speed, with another public body or among 2 or more components of a public body having a substantial interest in the determination or in the subject matter of this request.

A response to your request, with the five-day extension, will be provided by 03/27/2026.
