Re: FOIA Request 26-1140

Dear Sam Grayson:

I am responding to your request dated May 4, 2026, and received in my office May 5, 2026, under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) in which you requested:

1. "'Flock networks that I'm sharing" and "Flock networks shared with me" (Flock admin portal > Shared Networks > Download CSV) for UIUC PD, UIS PD, and UIC PD. Please provide as CSV or XLSX.
2. Flock Network audit for Feb 26-27, 2026 (Flock admin portal > Insights > Network Audit) for for UIUC PD, UIS PD, and UIC PD. Please provide as CSV or XLSX. Please retain the following columns: ID, Org Name, Time Frame, Search Time. You may redact or delete every other column. The retained columns do not contain free-form text, only search IDs, organization names, timestamps, and search types. This will help avoid a row-by-row or cell-by-cell redaction process.
3. The replacement Flock contract, referred to by Jamie L. Turpin on April 2, in response to FOIA 26-597, when writing "The replacement contract is being reviewed...". Note that if this item is provided in 26-1107, it need not also be provided here."

Information responsive to **item #1** and **item #3** of your request are available and attached. These are public records numbering 594 pages. Some of these files provided to you are in tabular format (CSV, Excel, Database, etc.). As this file type allows for editing of the included data, you accept responsibility for accurate dissemination of this information and agree that no manipulation of the file that results in modification or falsification of the information will occur.

Portions of these records have been redacted pursuant to the following section(s) of the Act:

- 140/7(1)(b) that exempts from disclosure "Private information, unless disclosure is required by another provision of this Act, a State or federal law or a court order." This includes signatures.
- 140/7(1)(o) that exempts from disclosure "Administrative or technical information associated with automated data processing operations, including, but not limited to,

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software, operating protocols, computer program abstracts, file layouts, source listings, object modules, load modules, user guides, documentation pertaining to all logical and physical design of computerized systems, employee manuals, and any other information that, if disclosed, would jeopardize the security of the system or its data or the security of materials exempt under this Section.” This includes DocuSign identification numbers.

Item #2 of your request is denied pursuant to the following section(s) of the Act:

- 140/7(1)(a) that exempts from disclosure “Information specifically prohibited from disclosure by federal or State law or rules and regulations implementing under federal or State law.” The Illinois Vehicle Code requires ALPR information to be held confidentially to the fullest extent permitted by law. (625 ILCS 5/2-130(d)).
- 140/7(1)(d-7) that exempts from disclosure “Information gathered or records created from the use of automatic license plate readers in connection with Section 2-130 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.”

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General. The PAC may be reached by phone at 877-299-3642, or by postal mail to Leah Bartelt, Public Access Counselor, Office of the Illinois Attorney General, 500 South 2nd Street, Springfield, Illinois 62701. You also have the right to seek judicial review under section 11 of this Act.
