I am responding to your request dated April 18, 2026, and received in my office April 20, 2026, under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) in which you requested:

1. ""The most recent ALPR audit from "random auditing", referred to by UI PD Policy Manual 429.2.
2. The most recent ALPR "scheduled audit", referred to described by Policy Manual 429.2
3. The most recent ALPR "regular data quality review", described by UI PD Policy Manual 429.4.3.
4. The most recent ALPR "annual evaluation report", described by UI PD Policy Manual 429.5.2.
5. Training materials including user manuals for Flock ALPR systems including those created for UI PD Policy Manual 429.6 and manuals produced by Flock."
