Commander Murray,

During my regular monthly Flock report/audit, I noticed some suspicious activity regarding Officer Cole-Clark #208. From the dates of 12/10/2024 to 12/31/2024 I noticed that Officer Cole-Clark conducted an unusual amount of inquiries, approximately 329 inquiries (see attachment) . I discovered the following:

Illinois License Plate [REDACTED] was ran 93 times.

I conducted an SOS/LEADS search on the plate as well as conducted an In-House search which revealed no local contacts with Matteson PD. The vehicle registered to [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]) from [REDACTED] Lynwood, IL. 60411 and IL DL registered to [REDACTED] Chicago, IL. 60628.

Illinois License Plate [REDACTED] was ran 201 times.

I conducted an SOS/LEADS search on the plate as well as conducted an In-House search which revealed no local contacts with Matteson PD. The vehicle and IL DL registered to [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]) from [REDACTED] Hazel Crest, IL. 60429.

Illinois License Plate [REDACTED] was ran 7 times.

I conducted an SOS/LEADS search on the plate as well as conducted an In-House search which revealed no local contacts with Matteson PD. The vehicle registered to [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] Matteson, IL. 60443

My concern is to make sure that this tool/resource is being used within Department Policy and not for personal reasons.

## Standards of Conduct

### 321.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This policy establishes standards of conduct that are consistent with the values and mission of the Matteson Police Department and are expected of all department members. The standards contained in this policy are not intended to be an exhaustive list of requirements and prohibitions but they do identify many of the important matters concerning conduct. In addition to the provisions of this policy, members are subject to all other provisions contained in this manual, as well as any additional guidance on conduct that may be disseminated by this department or a member's supervisors.

### 321.2 POLICY

The continued employment or appointment of every member of the Matteson Police Department shall be based on conduct that reasonably conforms to the guidelines set forth herein. Failure to meet the guidelines set forth in this policy, whether on- or off-duty, may be cause for disciplinary action.

### 321.3 DIRECTIVES AND ORDERS

Members shall comply with lawful directives and orders from any department supervisor or person in a position of authority, absent a reasonable and bona fide justification.

#### 321.3.1 UNLAWFUL OR CONFLICTING ORDERS

Supervisors shall not knowingly issue orders or directives that, if carried out, would result in a violation of any law or department policy. Supervisors should not issue orders that conflict with any previous order without making reasonable clarification that the new order is intended to countermand the earlier order.

No member is required to obey any order that appears to be in direct conflict with any federal law, state law or local ordinance. Following a known unlawful order is not a defense and does not relieve the member from criminal or civil prosecution or administrative discipline. If the legality of an order is in doubt, the affected member shall ask the issuing supervisor to clarify the order or shall confer with a higher authority in the chain-of-command. The responsibility for refusal to obey rests with the member, who shall subsequently be required to justify the refusal.

Unless it would jeopardize the safety of any individual, members who are presented with a lawful order that is in conflict with a previous lawful order, department policy, or other directive shall respectfully inform the issuing supervisor of the conflict. The issuing supervisor is responsible for either resolving the conflict or clarifying that the lawful order is intended to countermand the previous lawful order or directive, in which case the member is obliged to comply. Members who are compelled to follow a conflicting lawful order after having given the issuing supervisor the opportunity to correct the conflict, will not be held accountable for disobedience of the lawful order or directive that was initially issued.

The person countermanding the original order shall notify, in writing, the person issuing the original order, indicating the action taken and the reason.

#### **321.3.2 SUPERVISOR RESPONSIBILITIES**

Supervisors are required to follow all policies and procedures and may be subject to discipline for:

- (a) Failure to be reasonably aware of the performance of their subordinates or to provide appropriate guidance and control.
- (b) Failure to promptly and fully report any known misconduct of a member to his/her immediate supervisor or to document such misconduct appropriately or as required by policy.
- (c) Directing a subordinate to violate a policy or directive, acquiesce to such a violation, or are indifferent to any such violation by a subordinate.
- (d) The unequal or disparate exercise of authority on the part of a supervisor toward any member for malicious or other improper purpose.

#### **321.4 GENERAL STANDARDS**

Members shall conduct themselves, whether on- or off-duty, in accordance with the United States and Illinois constitutions and all applicable laws, ordinances, and rules enacted or established pursuant to legal authority.

Members shall familiarize themselves with policies and procedures and are responsible for compliance with each. Members should seek clarification and guidance from supervisors in the event of any perceived ambiguity or uncertainty.

Discipline may be initiated for any good cause. It is not mandatory that a specific policy or rule violation be cited to sustain discipline. This policy is not intended to cover every possible type of misconduct.

#### **321.5 CAUSES FOR DISCIPLINE**

The following are illustrative of causes for disciplinary action. This list is not intended to cover every possible type of misconduct and does not preclude the recommendation of disciplinary action for violation of other rules, standards, ethics, and specific action or inaction that is detrimental to efficient department service.

##### **321.5.1 LAWS, RULES, AND ORDERS**

- (a) Violation of, or ordering or instructing a subordinate to violate any policy, procedure, rule, order, directive, requirement, or failure to follow instructions contained in department or Village manuals.
- (b) Disobedience of any legal directive or order issued by any department member of a higher rank.
- (c) Violation of federal, state, local, or administrative laws, rules, or regulations.

#### 321.5.2 ETHICS

- (a) Using or disclosing one's status as a member of the Matteson Police Department in any way that could reasonably be perceived as an attempt to gain influence or authority for non-department business or activity.
- (b) The wrongful or unlawful exercise of authority on the part of any member for malicious purpose, personal gain, willful deceit or any other improper purpose.
- (c) The receipt or acceptance of a reward, fee or gift from any person for service incident to the performance of the member's duties.
- (d) Acceptance of fees, gifts or money contrary to the rules of this department and/or laws of the state.
- (e) Offer or acceptance of a bribe or gratuity.
- (f) Misappropriation or misuse of public funds, property, personnel or services.
- (g) Any other failure to abide by the standards of ethical conduct.

#### 321.5.3 DISCRIMINATION, OPPRESSION, OR FAVORITISM

Unless required by law or policy, discriminating against, oppressing, or providing favoritism to any person because of actual or perceived characteristics such as race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, age, disability, economic status, cultural group, veteran status, marital status, and any other classification or status protected by law, or intentionally denying or impeding another in the exercise or enjoyment of any right, privilege, power, or immunity, knowing the conduct is unlawful.

#### 321.5.4 RELATIONSHIPS

- (a) Unwelcome solicitation of a personal or sexual relationship while on-duty or through the use of one's official capacity.
- (b) Engaging in on-duty sexual activity including, but not limited to, sexual intercourse, excessive displays of public affection, or other sexual contact.
- (c) Establishing or maintaining an inappropriate personal or financial relationship, as a result of an investigation, with a known victim, witness, suspect, or defendant while a case is being investigated or prosecuted, or as a direct result of any official contact.
- (d) Associating with, or joining, a criminal gang, organized crime and/or criminal syndicate when the member knows, or reasonably should know, of the criminal nature of the organization. This includes any organization involved in a definable criminal activity or enterprise, except as specifically directed and authorized by this department.
- (e) Associating on a personal, rather than official basis, with persons who demonstrate recurring involvement in serious violations of state or federal laws after the member knows, or reasonably should know, of such criminal activities, except as specifically directed and authorized by this department.

#### 321.5.5 ATTENDANCE

- (a) Leaving the job to which the member is assigned during duty hours without a reasonable excuse and proper permission and approval.
- (b) Unexcused or unauthorized absence or tardiness.
- (c) Excessive absenteeism or abuse of leave privileges.
- (d) Failure to report to work or to the place of assignment at the time specified and fully prepared to perform duties without a reasonable excuse.

#### 321.5.6 UNAUTHORIZED ACCESS, DISCLOSURE, OR USE

- (a) Unauthorized and inappropriate intentional release of confidential or protected information, materials, data, forms, or reports obtained as a result of the member's position with this department.
- (b) Disclosing active or protected investigation information to any unauthorized person.
- (c) The use of any information, photograph, video, or other recording obtained or accessed as a result of employment or appointment to this department for personal or financial gain or without the express authorization of the Chief of Police or the authorized designee.
- (d) Loaning, selling, allowing unauthorized use, giving away, or appropriating any department property for personal use, personal gain, or any other improper or unauthorized use or purpose.
- (e) Using department resources in association with any portion of an independent civil action. These resources include but are not limited to personnel, vehicles, equipment, and non-subpoenaed records.

#### 321.5.7 EFFICIENCY

- (a) Neglect of duty.
- (b) Unsatisfactory work performance including but not limited to failure, incompetence, inefficiency, or delay in performing and/or carrying out proper orders, work assignments, or the instructions of supervisors without a reasonable and bona fide excuse.
- (c) Concealing, attempting to conceal, removing, or destroying defective or incompetent work.
- (d) Unauthorized sleeping during on-duty time or assignments.
- (e) Failure to notify the Department within 24 hours of any change in residence address or contact numbers.
- (f) Failure to notify the Department of Human Resources of changes relevant to personal information (e.g., information associated with benefits determination) in a timely fashion.

#### 321.5.8 PERFORMANCE

- (a) Failure to disclose or misrepresenting material facts, or making any false or misleading statement on any application, examination form, or other official document, report or form, or during the course of any work-related investigation.
- (b) The falsification of any work-related records, making misleading entries or statements with the intent to deceive, or the willful and unauthorized removal, alteration, destruction and/or mutilation of any department record, public record, book, paper or document.
- (c) Failure to participate in, or giving false or misleading statements, or misrepresenting or omitting material information to a supervisor or other person in a position of authority, in connection with any investigation or in the reporting of any department-related business.
- (d) Being untruthful or knowingly making false, misleading, or malicious statements that are reasonably calculated to harm the reputation, authority or official standing of this department or its members.
- (e) Disparaging remarks or conduct concerning duly constituted authority to the extent that such conduct disrupts the efficiency of this department or subverts the good order, efficiency and discipline of this department or that would tend to discredit any of its members.
- (f) Unlawful gambling or unlawful betting at any time or any place. Legal gambling or betting under any of the following conditions:
  - 1. While on department premises.
  - 2. At any work site, while on-duty or while in uniform, or while using any department equipment or system.
  - 3. Gambling activity undertaken as part of an officer's official duties and with the express knowledge and permission of a direct supervisor is exempt from this prohibition.
- (g) Improper political activity including:
  - (a) Unauthorized attendance while on-duty at official legislative or political sessions.
  - (b) Solicitations, speeches, or distribution of campaign literature for, or against, any political candidate or position while on-duty or on department property except as expressly authorized by Village policy, the collective bargaining agreement, or the Chief of Police.
- (h) Engaging in political activities during assigned working hours except as expressly authorized by Village policy, the collective bargaining agreement, or the Chief of Police.
- (i) Any act on- or off-duty that brings discredit to this department.

#### 321.5.9 CONDUCT

- (a) Failure of any member to promptly and fully report activities on his/her part or the part of any other member where such activities resulted in contact with any other law

enforcement agency or that may result in criminal prosecution or discipline under this policy.

- (b) Unreasonable and unwarranted force to a person encountered or a person under arrest.
- (c) Exceeding lawful peace officer powers by unreasonable, unlawful or excessive conduct.
- (d) Unauthorized or unlawful fighting, threatening or attempting to inflict unlawful bodily harm on another.
- (e) Engaging in horseplay that reasonably could result in injury or property damage.
- (f) Discourteous, disrespectful or discriminatory treatment of any member of the public or any member of this department or the Village.
- (g) Use of obscene, indecent, profane or derogatory language while on-duty or in uniform.
- (h) Criminal, dishonest, or disgraceful conduct, whether on- or off-duty, that adversely affects the member's relationship with this department.
- (i) Unauthorized possession of, loss of, or damage to department property or the property of others, or endangering it through carelessness or maliciousness.
- (j) Attempted or actual theft of department property; misappropriation or misuse of public funds, property, personnel or the services or property of others; unauthorized removal or possession of department property or the property of another person.
- (k) Activity that is incompatible with a member's conditions of employment or appointment as established by law or that violates a provision of any collective bargaining agreement or contract to include fraud in securing the appointment or hire.
- (l) Initiating any civil action for recovery of any damages or injuries incurred in the course and scope of employment or appointment without first notifying the Chief of Police of such action.
- (m) Any other on- or off-duty conduct which any member knows or reasonably should know is unbecoming a member of this department, is contrary to good order, efficiency or morale, or tends to reflect unfavorably upon this department or its members.

#### 321.5.10 SAFETY

- (a) Failure to observe or violating department safety standards or safe working practices.
- (b) Failure to maintain current licenses or certifications required for the assignment or position (e.g., driver's license, first aid, etc.).
- (c) Failure to maintain good physical condition sufficient to adequately and safely perform law enforcement duties.
- (d) Unsafe firearm or other dangerous weapon handling to include loading or unloading firearms in an unsafe manner, either on- or off-duty.
- (e) Carrying, while on the premises of the work place, any firearm or other lethal weapon that is not authorized by the member's appointing authority.

- (f) Unsafe or improper driving habits or actions in the course of employment or appointment.
- (g) Any personal action contributing to a preventable traffic crash.
- (h) Concealing or knowingly failing to report any on-the-job or work-related accident or injury as soon as practicable but within 24 hours.

#### 321.5.11 INTOXICANTS

- (a) Reporting for work or being at work while intoxicated or when the member's ability to perform assigned duties is impaired due to the use of alcohol, medication or drugs, whether legal, prescribed, or illegal.
- (b) Possession or use of alcohol at any work site or while on-duty, except as authorized in the performance of an official assignment. A member who is authorized to consume alcohol is not permitted to do so to such a degree that it may impair on-duty performance or driving.
- (c) Unauthorized possession, use of, or attempting to bring a controlled substance, illegal drug, or non-prescribed medication to any work site.

## Information Technology Use

### 322.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for the proper use of department information technology resources, including computers, electronic devices, hardware, software, and systems.

#### 322.1.1 DEFINITIONS

Definitions related to this policy include:

**Computer system** - All computers (on-site and portable), electronic devices, hardware, software, and resources owned, leased, rented or licensed by the Matteson Police Department that are provided for official use by its members. This includes all access to, and use of, Internet Service Providers (ISP) or other service providers provided by or through the Department or department funding.

**Hardware** - Includes, but is not limited to, computers, computer terminals, network equipment, electronic devices, telephones, including cellular and satellite, pagers, modems or any other tangible computer device generally understood to comprise hardware.

**Software** - Includes, but is not limited to, all computer programs, systems and applications, including shareware. This does not include files created by the individual user.

**Temporary file, permanent file or file** - Any electronic document, information or data residing or located, in whole or in part, on the system including, but not limited to, spreadsheets, calendar entries, appointments, tasks, notes, letters, reports, messages, photographs or videos.

### 322.2 POLICY

It is the policy of the Matteson Police Department that members shall use information technology resources, including computers, software and systems, that are issued or maintained by the Department in a professional manner and in accordance with this policy.

### 322.3 PRIVACY EXPECTATION

Members forfeit any expectation of privacy with regard to emails, texts, or anything published, shared, transmitted, or maintained through file-sharing software or any Internet site that is accessed, transmitted, received, or reviewed on any department computer system.

The Department reserves the right to access, audit, and disclose, for whatever reason, any message, including attachments, and any information accessed, transmitted, received, or reviewed over any technology that is issued or maintained by the Department, including the department email system, computer network and/or any information placed into storage on any department system or device. This includes records of all keystrokes or Web-browsing history made at any department computer or over any department network. The fact that access to a database, service, or website requires a username or password will not create an expectation of privacy if it is accessed through department computers, electronic devices, or networks.

The Department shall not request, require, or coerce a member to provide a username, password, or other related account information, or require or coerce a member to invite other members to join a group affiliated with any personal account of the member or to join a member's list of contacts in order to gain access to the member's account or profile on a personal online account (820 ILCS 55/10).

#### **322.4 RESTRICTED USE**

Members shall not access computers, devices, software or systems for which they have not received prior authorization or the required training. Members shall immediately report unauthorized access or use of computers, devices, software or systems by another member to their supervisors or Watch Commanders.

Members shall not use another person's access passwords, logon information, and other individual security data, protocols, and procedures unless directed to do so by a supervisor.

##### **322.4.1 SOFTWARE**

Members shall not copy or duplicate any copyrighted or licensed software except for a single copy for backup purposes in accordance with the software company's copyright and license agreement.

To reduce the risk of a computer virus or malicious software, members shall not install any unlicensed or unauthorized software on any department computer. Members shall not install personal copies of any software onto any department computer.

When related to criminal investigations, software program files may be downloaded only with the approval of the information systems technology (IT) staff and with the authorization of the Chief of Police or the authorized designee.

No member shall knowingly make, acquire, or use unauthorized copies of computer software that is not licensed to the Department while on department premises, computer systems, or electronic devices. Such unauthorized use of software exposes the Department and involved members to severe civil and criminal penalties.

Introduction of software by members should only occur as part of the automated maintenance or update process of department- or Village-approved or installed programs by the original manufacturer, producer, or developer of the software.

Any other introduction of software requires prior authorization from IT staff and a full scan for malicious attachments.

##### **322.4.2 HARDWARE**

Access to technology resources provided by, or through, the Department shall be strictly limited to department-related activities. Data stored on, or available through, department computer systems shall only be accessed by authorized members who are engaged in an active investigation or assisting in an active investigation, or who otherwise have a legitimate law enforcement or department-related purpose to access such data. Any exceptions to this policy must be approved by a supervisor.

#### **322.4.3 INTERNET USE**

Internet access provided by, or through, the Department shall be strictly limited to department-related activities. Internet sites containing information that is not appropriate or applicable to department use, and which shall not be intentionally accessed include, but are not limited to, adult forums, pornography, gambling, chat rooms, and similar or related Internet sites. Certain exceptions may be permitted with the express approval of a supervisor as a function of a member's assignment.

Downloaded information shall be limited to messages, mail, and data files.

#### **322.4.4 OFF-DUTY USE**

Members shall only use technology resources provided by the Department while on-duty or in conjunction with specific on-call assignments unless specifically authorized by a supervisor. This includes the use of telephones, cell phones, texting, email or any other "off the clock" work-related activities. This also applies to personally owned devices that are used to access department resources.

Refer to the Personal Communication Devices Policy for guidelines regarding off-duty use of personally owned technology.

#### **322.5 PROTECTION OF AGENCY SYSTEMS AND FILES**

All employees have a duty to protect the system and related systems and devices from physical and environmental damage and are responsible for the correct use, operation, care, and maintenance of the system.

Members shall ensure department computers and access terminals are not viewable by persons who are not authorized users. Computers and terminals should be secured, users logged off, and password protections enabled whenever the user is not present. Access passwords, logon information, and other individual security data, protocols, and procedures are confidential information and are not to be shared. Password length, format, structure, and content shall meet the prescribed standards required by the computer system or as directed by a supervisor and shall be changed at intervals as directed by IT staff or a supervisor.

It is prohibited for an employee to allow an unauthorized user to access the system at any time or for any reason. Members shall promptly report any unauthorized access to the computer system or suspected intrusion from outside sources (including the Internet) to a supervisor.

#### **322.6 INSPECTION OR REVIEW**

A supervisor, or the authorized designee, has the express authority to inspect or review the computer system, all temporary or permanent files, related electronic systems or devices, and any contents thereof, whether such inspection or review is in the ordinary course of his/her supervisory duties or based on cause.

Reasons for inspection or review may include, but are not limited to, computer system malfunctions, problems or general computer system failure, a lawsuit against the Department

involving one of its members or a member's duties, an alleged or suspected violation of any department policy, a request for disclosure of data, or a need to perform or provide a service.

The IT staff may extract, download, or otherwise obtain any and all temporary or permanent files residing or located in or on the department computer system when requested by a supervisor or during the course of regular duties that require such information.

## Mobile Digital Terminal Use

### 424.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose of this policy is to establish guidelines for the proper access, use and application of the Mobile Digital Terminal (MDT) system in order to ensure appropriate access to confidential records from local, state and national law enforcement databases, and to ensure effective electronic communications between department members and the Dispatch Center.

### 424.2 POLICY

Matteson Police Department members using the MDT shall comply with all appropriate federal and state rules and regulations and shall use the MDT in a professional manner, in accordance with this policy.

### 424.3 PRIVACY EXPECTATION

Members forfeit any expectation of privacy with regard to messages accessed, transmitted, received or reviewed on any department technology system (see the Information Technology Use Policy for additional guidance).

### 424.4 RESTRICTED ACCESS AND USE

MDT use is subject to the Information Technology Use and Protected Information policies.

Members shall not access the MDT system if they have not received prior authorization and the required training. Members shall immediately report unauthorized access or use of the MDT by another member to their supervisors or Watch Commanders.

Use of the MDT system to access law enforcement databases or transmit messages is restricted to official activities, business-related tasks and communications that are directly related to the business, administration or practices of the Department. In the event that a member has questions about sending a particular message or accessing a particular database, the member should seek prior approval from his/her supervisor.

Sending derogatory, defamatory, obscene, disrespectful, sexually suggestive, harassing or any other inappropriate messages on the MDT system is prohibited and may result in discipline.

It is a violation of this policy to transmit a message or access a law enforcement database under another member's name or to use the password of another member to log in to the MDT system unless directed to do so by a supervisor. Members are required to log off the MDT or secure the MDT when it is unattended. This added security measure will minimize the potential for unauthorized access or misuse.

#### 424.4.1 USE WHILE DRIVING

Use of the MDT by the vehicle operator should be limited to times when the vehicle is stopped. Information that is required for immediate enforcement, investigative, tactical or safety needs should be transmitted over the radio.

In no case shall an operator attempt to send or review lengthy messages while the vehicle is in motion.

#### **424.5 DOCUMENTATION OF ACTIVITY**

Except as otherwise directed by the Watch Commander or other department-established protocol, all calls for service assigned by a dispatcher should be communicated by voice over the police radio and electronically via the MDT unless security or confidentiality prevents such broadcasting.

MDT and voice transmissions are used to document the member's daily activity. To ensure accuracy:

- (a) All contacts or activity shall be documented at the time of the contact.
- (b) Whenever the activity or contact is initiated by voice, it should be documented by a dispatcher.
- (c) Whenever the activity or contact is not initiated by voice, the member shall document it via the MDT.

##### **424.5.1 STATUS CHANGES**

All changes in status (e.g., arrival at scene, meal periods, in service) will be transmitted over the police radio or through the MDT system.

Members responding to in-progress calls should advise changes in status over the radio to assist other members responding to the same incident. Other changes in status can be made on the MDT when the vehicle is not in motion.

##### **424.5.2 EMERGENCY ACTIVATION**

If there is an emergency activation and the member does not respond to a request for confirmation of the need for emergency assistance or confirms the need, available resources will be sent to assist in locating the member. If the location is known, the nearest available officer should respond in accordance with the Officer Response to Calls Policy.

Members should ensure a field supervisor and the Watch Commander are notified of the incident without delay.

Officers not responding to the emergency shall refrain from transmitting on the police radio until a no-further-assistance broadcast is made or if they are also handling an emergency.

#### **424.6 EQUIPMENT CONSIDERATIONS**

##### **424.6.1 MALFUNCTIONING**

Whenever possible, members will not use vehicles with malfunctioning MDTs. Whenever members must drive a vehicle in which the MDT is not working, they shall notify the Dispatch Center. It shall be the responsibility of the dispatcher to document all information that will then be transmitted verbally over the police radio.

#### 424.6.2 BOMB CALLS

When investigating reports of possible bombs, members should not communicate on their MDTs when in the evacuation area of a suspected explosive device. Radio frequency emitted by the MDT could cause some devices to detonate.

## Protected Information

### 805.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for the access, transmission, release, and security of protected information by members of the Matteson Police Department. This policy addresses the protected information that is used in the day-to-day operation of the Department and not the public records information covered in the Records Maintenance and Release Policy.

#### 805.1.1 DEFINITIONS

Definitions related to this policy include:

**Protected information** - Any information or data that is collected, stored, or accessed by members of the Matteson Police Department and is subject to any access or release restrictions imposed by law, regulation, order, or use agreement. This includes all information contained in federal, state, or local law enforcement databases that is not accessible to the public.

### 805.2 POLICY

Members of the Matteson Police Department will adhere to all applicable laws, orders, regulations, use agreements, and training related to the access, use, dissemination, and release of protected information.

### 805.3 RESPONSIBILITIES

The Chief of Police shall select a member of the Department to coordinate the use of protected information.

The responsibilities of this position include, but are not limited to (20 Ill. Adm. Code 1240.90):

- (a) Ensuring member compliance with this policy and with requirements applicable to protected information, including requirements for the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) system, National Law Enforcement Telecommunications System (NLETS), Illinois Secretary of State records, and the Illinois Law Enforcement Agencies Data Systems (LEADS).
- (b) Developing, disseminating, and maintaining procedures that adopt or comply with the U.S. Department of Justice's current Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Security Policy.
- (c) Developing, disseminating, and maintaining any other procedures necessary to comply with any other requirements for the access, use, dissemination, release, and security of protected information.
- (d) Developing procedures to ensure training and certification requirements are met.
- (e) Resolving specific questions that arise regarding authorized recipients of protected information.
- (f) Ensuring security practices and procedures are in place to comply with requirements applicable to protected information.

#### **805.4 ACCESS TO PROTECTED INFORMATION**

Protected information shall not be accessed in violation of any law, order, regulation, user agreement, Matteson Police Department policy or training. Only those members who have completed applicable training and met any applicable requirements, such as a background check, may access protected information, and only when the member has a legitimate work-related reason for such access (20 Ill. Adm. Code 1240.50).

Unauthorized access, including access for other than a legitimate work-related purpose, is prohibited and may subject a member to administrative action pursuant to the Personnel Complaints Policy and/or criminal prosecution (20 ILCS 2630/7; 20 Ill. Adm. Code 1240.50).

##### **805.4.1 PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE OR MISUSE OF RECORDS**

The Department of State Police may suspend all, or any portion of, LEADS service without prior notification as the result of an agency's non-compliance with laws, rules, regulations, or procedures. The Director of State Police may suspend all, or part of, LEADS service for agency for violations of LEADS laws, rules regulations, or procedures (20 Ill. Adm. Code 1240.110).

It is a Class A misdemeanor to furnish, buy, receive, or possess LEADS information without authorization by a court, statute, or case law (20 ILCS 2630/7).

#### **805.5 RELEASE OR DISSEMINATION OF PROTECTED INFORMATION**

Protected information may be released only to authorized recipients who have both a right to know and a need to know (20 Ill. Adm. Code 1240.50; 20 Ill. Adm. Code 1240.80).

A member who is asked to release protected information that should not be released should refer the requesting person to a supervisor or to the Records Supervisor for information regarding a formal request.

Unless otherwise ordered, or when an investigation would be jeopardized, protected information maintained by the Department may generally be shared with authorized persons from other law enforcement agencies who are assisting in the investigation or conducting a related investigation. Any such information should be released through the Records Section to ensure proper documentation of the release (see the Records Maintenance and Release Policy).

Protected information, such as Criminal Justice Information (CJI), which includes Criminal History Record Information (CHRI), should generally not be transmitted by radio, cellular telephone or any other type of wireless transmission to members in the field or in vehicles through any computer or electronic device, except in cases where there is an immediate need for the information to further an investigation or where circumstances reasonably indicate that the immediate safety of officers, other department members or the public is at risk.

Nothing in this policy is intended to prohibit broadcasting warrant information.

#### **805.6 SECURITY OF PROTECTED INFORMATION**

The Chief of Police will select a member of the Department to oversee the security of protected information.

The responsibilities of this position include, but are not limited to:

- (a) Developing and maintaining security practices, procedures, and training.
- (b) Ensuring federal and state compliance with the CJIS Security Policy and the requirements of any state or local criminal history records systems (20 Ill. Adm. Code 1240.50).
- (c) Establishing procedures to provide for the preparation, prevention, detection, analysis, and containment of security incidents including computer attacks.
- (d) Tracking, documenting, and reporting all breach of security incidents to the Chief of Police and appropriate authorities.

#### **805.6.1 MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES**

Members accessing or receiving protected information shall ensure the information is not accessed or received by persons who are not authorized to access or receive it (20 Ill. Adm. Code 1240.80). This includes leaving protected information, such as documents or computer databases, accessible to others when it is reasonably foreseeable that unauthorized access may occur (e.g., on an unattended table or desk; in, or on, an unattended vehicle; in an unlocked desk drawer or file cabinet; on an unattended computer terminal) (20 Ill. Adm. Code 1240.50).

#### **805.6.2 MAINTENANCE AND TECHNICAL SERVICES**

The personnel security requirement for a LEADS agency requires conformance with 20 Ill. Adm. Code 1240.50. Generally, no person may provide maintenance or technical services at, or near, LEADS equipment unless they are of good character and have not been convicted of a felony or a crime involving moral turpitude under the laws of this or any other jurisdiction. Any person may have his/her authority to provide maintenance or technical services at, or near, LEADS equipment denied if he/she is charged with a felony or a crime involving moral turpitude under the laws of this or any other jurisdiction (20 Ill. Adm. Code 1240.50(3)).

#### **805.6.3 PROTECTION OF LEADS DATA**

LEADS data shall not be included on the violator's copy of any citation that is not delivered by hand to the violator. This specifically includes citation copies left on an unattended vehicle, a building, or any other place where the violator is not present to receive the citation. LEADS data will continue to be included on other copies of the citation that are kept by the employee and/or the Department (18 USC § 2721 through 18 USC § 2725).

#### **805.7 TRAINING**

All members authorized to access or release protected information shall complete a training program that complies with any protected information system requirements and identifies

authorized access and use of protected information, as well as its proper handling and dissemination.

The law provides that you are to be advised of the following:

1. Any admission made during this hearing, interrogation or examination may be used as evidence of misconduct and the basis for charges seeking your removal, discharge, or suspension from the department.
2. You have the right to the counsel of your choosing to be present with you to advise you at this hearing, interrogation, or examination and you may consult with that counsel as you desire at any stage of hearing, interrogation, or examination.
3. You have the right to be given a reasonable amount of time to obtain counsel of your choosing.
4. You have no right to remain silent. You have an obligation to truthfully answer all questions that are put to you. You are advised that your statements or responses constitute an official police report. Questions will be specifically and narrowly related to the performance of your official duties.
5. If you refuse to answer questions put to you, you will be ordered by a superior employee to answer the question.
6. If you persist in your refusal to answer, after being given an order to do so, you are advised that such refusal will constitute a violation of the Policies of the Matteson Police Department and subject you to discipline, including possible dismissal.
7. You are further advised that, by law, any admission that is made by you during the course of this hearing, interrogation or examination cannot be used against you in a subsequent criminal proceeding.
8. If you so request, a person of your choice may be present to serve as a witness during the interview(s).
9. You are hereby ordered not to discuss this investigation with anyone other than your counsel and union representative.

During a routine audit of the Flock ALPR cameras, it was noted that you conducted a search of Illinois registration [REDACTED] 93 times from 12-10-2024 to 12/31/2024. You conducted a search of Illinois registration [REDACTED] 201 times during that same period. Additionally, you searched your own Illinois registration, [REDACTED] seven times through Flock. The searches occurred while you were on and off duty.

The subsequent investigation revealed that you utilized your MDT computer to conduct Spillman and LEADS/NCIC name inquiries through the department's State Link on the two female registered owners for the vehicles with Illinois registrations [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. The investigation further concluded that you had a prior dating relationship with one of the two females whom you conducted the name inquiry on using the State Link.

The investigation into the below incident has been completed and there is sufficient cause that you have violated the following Department Policy(ies) (Copies Attached):

- **Policy 321 Standards of Conduct**
- **Policy 322 Information Technology Use**
- **Policy 424 Mobile Digital Terminal Use**
- **Policy 805 Protected Information**

**SUBJECT: Officer Cole-Clark Investigation**

On Thursday, January 2, 2025, at 2031 hours, Sergeant Daniel Vanoskey sent an email to the command staff alerting us to a suspicious amount of Flock inquiries conducted by Officer Jaila Cole-Clark during the month of December. As our agency's Flock Administrator, Sergeant Vanoskey is required to complete a monthly report documenting the usage by our officers. While preparing his December 2024 report, Sergeant Vanoskey determined that Officer Cole-Clark conducted a total of three hundred and twenty-nine searches through Flock between December 11, 2024, and December 31, 2024. Sergeant Vanoskey recognized the unusually high number of searches by Officer Cole Clark and conducted a more thorough review of her activity. Sergeant Vanoskey found that two hundred and ninety-four of the total searches were made on the following vehicles.

**Vehicle Information**

- Gray 2020 Nissan, Illinois registration [REDACTED] – 201 Flock searches  
Registered to [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED] Hazel Crest, IL.
- Black 2021 Chevrolet, Illinois registration [REDACTED] – 93 Flock searches  
Registered to [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED] Lynwood, IL.

Sergeant Vanoskey ran in house records searches on the vehicles and the registered owners through Spillman, and determined there had been no previous contact with the Matteson Police Department.

In addition to these inquiries, Officer Cole-Clark performed seven Flock searches on Illinois registration [REDACTED], which registers to Officer Cole-Clark at [REDACTED], Matteson, IL.

### **LEADS Inquiries**

On Friday, January 3, 2025, I initiated an internal investigation and began reviewing the Flock inquiries made by Officer Cole-Clark in December 2024. I conducted inquiries of the vehicle registrations through the Illinois Secretary of State and LEADS, which revealed no previous inquiries on the vehicles in the past ten days. The same inquiries were made on the registered owners of the vehicles, which revealed a name inquiry on [REDACTED] by this agency on Tuesday, December 24, 2024, at 11:08 p.m. I referenced the patrol schedule in the Power Time software and determined Officer Cole-Clark did work the night shift (1800-0600 hours). A check of Officer Cole-Clark's Unit Radio Log from the shift showed she ran name inquiries on [REDACTED] at 2308 hours, and [REDACTED] at 2305 hours from either a department mobile or desktop computer.

On Friday, January 10, 2025, I contacted the Illinois State Police and spoke with Public Service Administrator Charles Caudill with the Division of Justice Services/Program Administration Bureau. I provided Mr. Caudill with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] information, as well as their registration information, and requested he provide a [REDACTED] inquiries made by Officer Cole-Clark. On Tuesday, January 14, 2025, I received an email from Mr. Caudill containing two Illinois State Police Archive and Retrieval – Search Result Reports. The reports indicate a name and driver's license inquiry were ran on [REDACTED] by this agency on Tuesday, December 24, 2024, at 23.08.04 hours. Mr. Caudill explained that I would have to contact East Communications dispatch and their vendor for the user information, as they are required to store this information. Mr. Caudill did not find any inquiries made on [REDACTED] or the vehicle registration plates.

### **Spillman Technical Support**

On Friday, January 10, 2025, I contacted Spillman Technical Support and spoke with Colleen Studor. I provided Ms. Studor with the information for [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], as well as their vehicle registration, and asked that she conduct an inquiry search. Ms. Studor determined that Officer Cole-Clark ran name inquiries on both females through state link on December 24, 2024, at 2305 and 2308 hours. Ms. Studor provided screenshots showing the name inquiries through state link. Ms. Studor and Records Clerk/Spillman Administrator Jeanine Dropkowski explained that inquiries through state link provide our agency's access to LEADS information. I also spoke with Steve Lucas from Spillman Technical Support. Mr. Lucas also conducted an audit of inquiries by Officer Cole-Clark and verified these were the only inquiries on both females. Mr. Lucas did not find any record of inquiries on the vehicle registrations.

### **Interview**

On Thursday, January 9, 2025, at 1645 hours, I spoke with [REDACTED] by phone. I explained that a monthly audit of our LPR cameras revealed an unusual number of inquiries on her vehicle registration. [REDACTED] stated she frequently travels through Matteson while commuting to and from work. [REDACTED] indicated she has not had any contact with the Matteson Police Department. [REDACTED] did recall a traffic stop a couple of months ago on Rt. 30 at Main Street. This traffic stop was conducted by an Olympia Fields Officer. [REDACTED] advised she did not know any Matteson officers or why her registration would have been searched.

On Friday, January 10, 2025, I received a call back from [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] had a conversation with her partner, [REDACTED], about my phone call the day before. [REDACTED] informed [REDACTED] that her ex-partner, Jaila Cole-Clark, was a police officer in Matteson. [REDACTED] knew Jaila Cole-Clark was previously employed by the Blue Island Police Department and did not know she transferred to Matteson. [REDACTED] stated she never had contact with Jaila Cole-Clark, but she would see her patrolling in Blue Island when she lived there. [REDACTED] advised that she never had a problem with Jaila Cole-Clark and did not understand why Cole-Clark would be searching her vehicle registration. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have been in a relationship for two years.

### Interview

I was able to speak with [REDACTED] by phone after my conversation with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] explained that she had been in a dating relationship with Jaila Cole-Clark for about seven years. They started dating during their freshman year of high school and mutually agreed to end their relationship in 2022. [REDACTED] stated they are still friends today but rarely see or speak to each other. [REDACTED] advised Jaila Cole-Clark did send her a text message in early December to check in and see how she is doing. [REDACTED] indicated the conversation was short and she has not spoken to Jaila Cole-Clark since. [REDACTED] described their relationship as cordial and said there had not been any conflict. [REDACTED] also did not understand why Jaila Cole-Clark would make inquiries on her vehicle registration.

### Flock Inquiries

During this investigation, I reviewed the inquiries made by Officer Cole-Clark in December and compared the dates and times of the searches to Officer Cole-Clark's patrol schedule for the month. Officer Cole-Clark was assigned to the night shift (1800-0600 hours) for the entire month. The times of the inquiries are Coordinated Universal Time (UTC), so I converted them to Central Standard Time by going back six hours. I determined that Officer Cole-Clark conducted approximately 206 Flock inquiries on the registrations in December while she was off duty. On many days, Officer Cole-Clark would make numerous inquiries on the registrations within minutes of each other.

On Friday, January 10, 2025, Sergeant Vanoskey provided me with a list of Flock inquiries conducted by Officer Cole-Clark in the first week of January. Officer Cole-Clark conducted a total of 105 searches over the first seven days of the month. All but seven of the inquiries were on [REDACTED] (37 inquiries) and [REDACTED] (55 inquiries) registration. Officer Cole-Clark conducted 89 Flock inquiries while she was off duty.

In October and November of 2024, Officer Cole-Clark only conducted a combined 23 Flock inquiries compared to the 434 searches conducted in December and the first week of January. This activity shows a significant increase in searches and a continuous misuse of the Flock system over a one-month period.

### **LEADS Certificates**

On March 23, 2022, Officer Cole-Clark completed the Illinois State Police LEADS Full Access Initial training, with her certification expiring on March 23, 2024.

On April 8, 2024, Officer Cole-Clark completed the Illinois State Police LEADS Less Than Full Access training, with her certification expiring April 8, 2026.

The LEADS training specifically addresses authorized activity and emphasizes the use of LEADS for personal reasons is prohibited.

### **Matteson Police Department Policies**

Commander Dobrovits conducted a review of the department policies Officer Cole-Clark acknowledged since she joined the Matteson Police Department in July 2024. Commander Dobrovits is our agency's Lexipol Knowledge Management System Administrator. The review showed that Officer Cole-Clark only acknowledged six department policies since her hire date. All these policies were acknowledged on September 7, 2024. Officer Cole-Clark did acknowledge Policy 431 – Automated License Plate Readers (ALPRs). Sections 431.3 and 431.5(b) specifically state that members are allowed to access ALPR data for legitimate law enforcement purposes only and the database shall not be used for any unauthorized reason.

When a policy is issued or updated, every officer receives an email notification indicating the need for review. It is the officer's responsibility to review and acknowledge the policy. The following are among the policies Officer Cole-Clark failed to review and acknowledge.

- Policy 321 – Standards of Conduct
- Policy 322 – Information Technology Use
- Policy 424 – Mobile Digital Terminal Use
- Policy 805 – Protected Information

### **Notice of Investigation**

On Friday, January 10, 2025, Deputy Chief Sims and Commander Dobrovits met with Officer Cole-Clark and notified her that an internal investigation into her unauthorized use of LEADS and the Flock Automated License Plate Reader system was being conducted. Detective Roger Radtke was also present as Officer Cole-Clark's union representative. Deputy Chief Sims provided Officer Cole-Clark with her notice of charges and her administrative rights. An administrative hearing was set for Tuesday, January 21, 2025.

### **Administrative Hearing**

Officer Cole-Clark arrived at the police department around 10:00 am, but did not immediately enter the building. At 1003 hours, I looked out to the front lot and observed Officer Cole-Clark speaking with a group of officers. Commander Dobrovits and I went out to the parking lot to speak with Officer Cole-Clark. Officer Cole-Clark retrieved a box of department issued equipment from her vehicle and accompanied us to the training room. I asked Officer Cole Clark how she was

doing, and she responded, “I’m doing ok, I’m over it.” Officer Cole-Clark indicated she had consulted with her union counsel, and she was advised not to participate in the administrative hearing. Commander Dobrovits took inventory of her equipment and Officer Cole-Clark left the building.

### **Officer Cole-Clark Resignation**

Immediately after her departure from the police department, Officer Cole-Clark sent an email to the command staff indicating she would be resigning from her position with the Matteson Police Department on January 22, 2025. Officer Cole-Clark chose to forego the interview process because she believed it would not be taken into consideration based on her conduct being reported to the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board.

### **Investigation Summary**

After completing an audit of the Flock ALPR system for December 2024, Sergeant Vanoskey discovered an unusually high number of searches conducted by Officer Jaila Cole-Clark. Almost all the 294 searches by Officer Cole-Clark were on the same two vehicle registrations. A search of the Spillman database determined that Officer Cole-Clark had also ran name inquiries on both female owners on December 24, 2024. A check of Officer Cole-Clarks Spillman radio log for this date showed the name inquiries were made at 2305 and 2308 hours. I spoke with two Spillman technical support agents who confirmed the inquiries were made through state link, which provides this agency’s LEADS access. The Illinois State Police provided a Search Result Report indicating Officer Cole-Clark had made a LEADS name inquiry on one of the female vehicle owners. Furthermore, an audit of Officer Cole-Clark’s Flock use for the first week of January 2025 revealed the unauthorized activity continued with an additional ninety-two inquiries on the same vehicles. A review of Officer Cole-Clark’s patrol schedule for December and the First week of January showed that Officer Cole-Clark conducted numerous Flock searches while she was off duty.

I contacted both registered owners and learned that one of them is the former long-term partner of Officer Cole-Clark. The other female is the current partner of Officer Cole-Clark’s former partner. The former partner described having a cordial friendship with Officer Cole-Clark and could not provide a reason as to why Officer Cole-Clark would be conducting these searches.

Since being hired by the Matteson Police Department in July 2024, Officer Cole-Clark only reviewed and acknowledge six department policies. All these policies were acknowledged on September 7, 2024. Officer Cole-Clark did acknowledge Policy 431 – Automated License Plate Readers. This policy governs the use of the Flock ALPR system and specifically states specifically state that members are allowed to access ALPR data for legitimate law enforcement purposes only and the database shall not be used for any unauthorized reason. Officer Cole-Clark completed her LEADS recertification training in 2024 before joining the Matteson Police Department. The Illinois State Police LEADS Training describes authorized activity and emphasizes that personal use is prohibited. Officer Cole-Clark’s conduct violated several department and LEADS policies.

Officer Cole-Clark refused to cooperate with this investigation by refusing to participate in her administrative hearing on the advice of her union counsel. Instead, Officer Cole-Clark sent an

email to the command staff on January 21, 2025, indicating she would resign from her position with the Matteson Police Department.

All supporting documents related to this investigation were saved to the internal investigations file.

Recently, it was discovered that Officer Cole-Clark had been utilizing state and department resources to conduct vehicle and person searches of an ex-domestic partner and the ex-domestic partner's current partner. These searches were being conducted on and off duty. This is not only a violation department policy, but a violation of state a regulation(s), creating a potential catastrophic problem for the Matteson Police Department and the Village of Matteson should our access to state databases be restricted.

On today's date, I met with Officer Cole-Clark and informed her of the charges against her. Pursuant to the Uniform Police Officers' Disciplinary Act, she was provided with her Notice of Rights for a pending hearing on January 21, 2025 at 10am. The meeting was held in the presence of Officer Cole-Clark, her immediate supervisor, the Operations Commander, and her union representative.

During the meeting, she was informed that she was immediately being placed on paid Administrative Leave pending the outcome of the investigation and potential disciplinary hearing. Her key fob, badges, and police identification card were collected until a disposition has been reached in this matter.

I will keep you informed of our findings. Please feel free to contact me should you have any questions.
